

ED5153 Information Sheet – Continuing Education Credits at the Graduate Level

Online Course Design

Course Description

This semester-long online course prepares individuals and/or teams to design online courses for teachers or students. During the course, participants are guided through the process of defining course goals, readings, activities, discussion questions, alignment to state and national standards, assessment, and strategies for building a learning community. Additionally, training is provided in using the developer tools in the course management system. Upon completion of this course, participants will have created between 20-40 seat hours of content and a formal Course Completion Plan for completing their development work. Participants can take advantage of additional support and feedback from an ETLO staff person and an ongoing support forum during the year following this course.

Course Requirements

There are four requirements for successful completion of ED5153. Participants are required to develop a six-session online course. In addition, participants will submit to the instructor via email, a final product with the following three items:

- 1. Documentation of their active participation in the online course discussion,
- 2. A Self-Assessment Checklist designed to evaluate their course content and design in anticipation of completing the course and running it for participants,
- 3. An evaluation of their learning.
